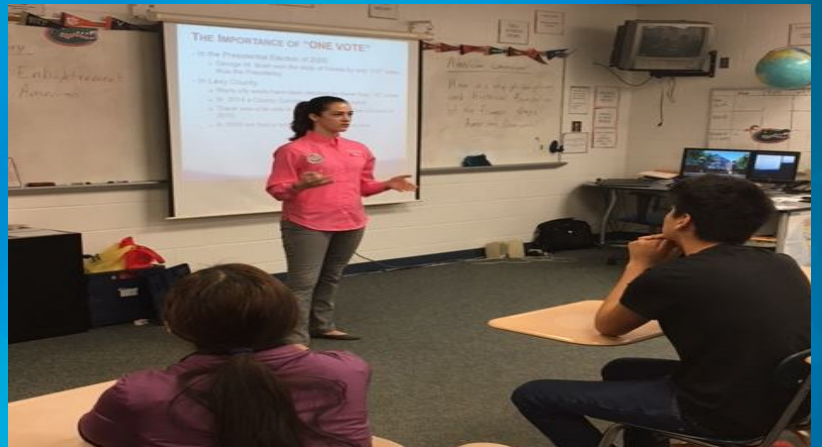


# Voter Outreach
