

The Levy County Supervisor of Elections is pleased to announce the Vote in Honor of a Veteran program. The program is not new around the state and country. Several other Florida counties and other states have variation of this program that is tailored to fit the needs in the communities.


The goal of our program is to recognize our veterans by encouraging voter participation among the entire voting population. By exercising our right to vote, we show veterans the respect they deserve for protecting our freedoms.

## *How it Works*

Veterans and family members of veterans who wish to participate will complete and submit a photo and a short biography on a form. The form may be completed by the veteran or by a family member of a veteran. There is no cost to participate.

On Election Day, or during Early Voting, anyone who desires to Vote in Honor of a Veteran will receive a special sticker that states: "My Vote Honors Veteran \_\_\_\_." You have the option of putting any veteran's name on the sticker whether the veteran is on our wall or not.

All Levy County Voters are encouraged to Vote in Honor of a Veteran. It is not necessary to be related to a veteran to vote in honor of one.



## *Veteran's Honor Wall*

The wall on the first floor of the Levy County Courthouse has been designated as our Veterans Honor Wall. Each veteran's photograph that is submitted will be posted on the wall.
